Programme Regulations 2015-2016

B.Sc. in Computer Applications

1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

The precision mark used to classify the degree is calculated by adding 85% of the precision mark for the 4th year of the programme to 15% of the precision mark for the 3rd year of the programme.

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

Marks and Standards apply.

3. Progression

Students must complete 60 credits to be permitted to progress to the next year of study. Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules except in exceptional circumstances and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board and mode of delivery permitting.

4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards, to all modules [Ref.: DCU M&S 7.2.8].
