Programme Regulations 2015-2016

B.Sc. Enterprise Computing

1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

Marks and Standards apply for years 1, 2, 3 and 4.

The precision mark used to classify the degree is calculated by adding 85% of the precision mark for the 4_{th} year of the programme to 15% of the precision mark for the 3_{rd} year of the programme.

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

Marks and Standards apply

3. Progression

Generally, students must successfully have completed a minimum of 60 credits in a study period in order to progress to the next study period. Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules except in exceptional circumstances and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board and mode of delivery permitting.

4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards, to all modules [Ref.: DCU M&S 7.2.8].
