Programme Regulations 2015-2016

BSc. in Manufacturing Engineering with Business Studies

1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

The 2nd year precision mark, where there is one, is included in the award classification calculation at a weighting of 10%, [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

The 3rd year precision mark is included in the award classification calculation at a weighting of 15%, [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

In the case of students who transferred into the programme in 3rd year – there is no 2nd year contribution, and the 3rd year precision mark is included in the award classification at a weighting of 15% [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

Marks and Standards apply.

3. Progression

Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules except in exceptional circumstances and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board and mode of delivery permitting.

4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards, to all modules [Ref.: DCU M&S 7.2.8].
