# Programme Regulations 2015-2016

## BSc. in Manufacturing Engineering with Business Studies

### 1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

The  $2_{nd}$  year precision mark, where there is one, is included in the award classification calculation at a weighting of 10%, [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

The  $3_{rd}$  year precision mark is included in the award classification calculation at a weighting of 15%, [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

In the case of students who transferred into the programme in  $3_{rd}$  year – there is no  $2_{nd}$  year contribution, and the  $3_{rd}$  year precision mark is included in the award classification at a weighting of 15% [Ref.: DCU M&S 8.1.1]

### 2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

Marks and Standards apply.

#### 3. Progression

Students will not be permitted to 'carry' modules except in exceptional circumstances and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board and mode of delivery permitting.

#### 4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards, to all modules [Ref.: DCU M&S 7.2.8].
