3. Progression

This is a continuous programme. Once students have met all requirements of the programme, within four years, they are eligible to graduate [Ref.: DCU M&S Items 5.1].

Students registered for the MA in Irish Studies who have successfully completed 30 ECTS credits of taught modules are permitted to exit from the programme with a Level 9 Graduate Certificate in Irish Studies [Ref.: DCU M&S Items 1.1.4, Item 8.1.5].

Students registered for the MA in Irish Studies who have successfully completed 60 ECTS credits of taught modules are permitted to exit from the programme with a Level 9 Graduate Diploma in Irish Studies [Ref.: DCU M&S Items 1.1.4, Item 8.1.5].

4. Compensation
