Programme Regulations 2015-2016

MSc in Nursing Practice/Health Care Practice (8 Streams)

1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

Students must complete a specialist out of area placement of between two weeks and three months as part of the programme.

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

Where there are specific modules with a distinct practice and theoretical element, there will not be compensation between theoretical and practical assignments. These modules are; NS5001, NS5011, NS5012 [Ref: DCU M&S: 6.2.2.]

3. Progression

This is a continuous programme.

Students can exit with a Graduate Diploma upon successful completion of 60 credits. Any required core modules for the exit awards are listed on the approved academic structure and will not include any credits from the dissertation/project element.
