



## **Programme Regulations 2015-2016 Master of Engineering Qualifier Programme (MEQc)**

### **1. Programme specific rules and requirements**

Candidates who pass 30 credits of taught modules may transfer to the Master of Engineering in Electronic Systems programme (MENc) or to the Master of Engineering in Telecommunications Engineering programme (MTCc), provided they obtain a minimum of 50% on level 8 taught modules.

The students who have already passed modules from the current MEQ academic structure and have used them as credit for a different qualification, cannot use them again towards accomplishing the 30 credits of the MEQc.

### **2. Derogations from Marks & Standards**

There are no derogations for this programme. Marks and Standards apply.

### **3. Progression**

This is a continuous programme. Once a candidate has met the programme requirements, they will be transferred.

### **4. Compensation**
