1. Programme Specific Rules and Requirements

2. Derogations from Marks and Standards

For the 2016-2017 academic session only, University Standards Committee has permitted the inclusion of 2.5-credit modules in English and Gaeilge on Year 3 of the BA in Humanities and Year 4 of the BA in Humanities (International) programme.

3. Progression

3.1 Credits for Progression

Students must normally have successfully completed a minimum of 60 credits in a study period in order to progress to the next study period.

In Year 3 students are required to register for either Year 3 of the BA in Humanities programme (SPDA 3) or to register for a Year Abroad on the BA in Humanities (International) programme (SPDAI 3). Only those students who successfully complete the Year Abroad and subsequently complete Year 4 will be eligible for the award of BA in Humanities (International).

4. Compensation

Compensation may apply, within the regulations specified in Marks and Standards, to all modules except the following:

5. Resit Categories

The resits offered for the August examinations diet vary depending on the module to be re-taken. The following is an explanation of the resit categories. All modules except those specified below fall into category 1.

Resit category 1: A resit is available for all components of the module.

Resit category 2: No resit is available where the module is 100% assessed by Continuous Assessment.
