Introduction to Articulate Studio'09

Workshop Overview:

Articulate Studio'09 software offers a user-friendly suite of flexible authoring tools which enables users to create engaging multimedia content suitable for online delivery. It integrates MS Power Point and allows for the integration of voice, video, flash based interactions and quizzes into visually appealing packages that can be delivered online within VLEs (i.e. Moodle) or on the Web. An overview of the key features of each tool will be presented along with examples of use and further recommended resources. Participants will have the opportunity to explore each of the tools themselves with hands-on guided tasks throughout the session.

Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this workshop you will be able to:

- Understand the capabilities and potential of the Articulate Studio '09 identifying how each of the tools can be used for online content creation and/or presentations.
- Create content suitable for delivery via online platforms by converting/publishing PowerPoint content using the Articulate Studio'09 tools.
