

LI502 Assessment and Feedback Module

This module focuses on the principles, application and context of assessment in higher education today. Participants will experience assessment approaches ('of', 'for' and 'as' learning) in on-line contexts. This module aims to equip participants with the skills to evaluate and develop appropriate online assessment and approaches to assessment.

Who is it for?

Practitioners who are currently involved in assessing student work whether they teach in a face to face, blended, or fully online environment.

How does it work?

LI502 is taught primarily online using Loop (Moodle) as the VLE. There is an important face-to-face orientation session to prepare for the module. A series of regular interactive activities and virtual classroom sessions enable you to discuss concepts and practices with your peers. Multimedia learning objects, videos, and articles are released fortnightly and there are opportunities to evaluate, try, and share practice. The module culminates in the design of an assessment strategy for a module in your context.

How much time is involved?

Below is an outline of the expected time commitment:

- Face-to-face learning 5 hours
- o Online participation 40 hours
- o Independent learning 40 hours
- o Assignments 40 hours
