SECTION A: MINUTES AND RELATED ISSUES

1. Adoption of the agenda

- 3.2 It was <u>noted</u> that all amendments to the *Academic Regulations for Postgraduate*Degrees by Research and Thesis 2019-20 were completed and will be submitted to the next meeting of University Standards Committee for consideration (Item 7).
- 3.3 It was noted that work on guidelines on recital/performance is ongoing (Item 3.3).

3.4 It was <u>noted</u> that follow-up with respect to a PGR3 form for a student in the School of Computing, where provision of more detail in section B(i) and B(ii) of the form was requested, is still ongoing (Item 3.6), (Original ref. 9.7, 25 October 2018).
