### 1.1 Calculation for the Award Classification

The calculation of the final year award classification includes contributions from previous year's results, as follows: From 2016/17, $3^{\text {rd }} \& 4$ th year precision marks will be included in the award classification calculation at the following weightings:

### 1.2. Monitored Attendance
