2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

M&S Ref: Derogation from 6.2.2 of Marks and Standards (the Teaching Council of Ireland requires pre-service Physical Education teachers to be competent in the performance of a number of practical areas for academic accreditation);
A minimum of 40% must be achieved in both the examination and CA elements for an overall pass in Modules SS113, SS123, SS223, SS228

3. Progression

Students must obtain the minimum number of credits indicated below in the relevant academic session to progress to the next academic session. This has been approved as a derogation.

Year One - 67.5 credits

Year Two - 70 credits

Year Three - 70 credits

Year Four - 75 credits

A student will not be permitted to embark on fourth year teaching practice (module ES305) carrying a module.

4. Compensation

Compensation does not apply to modules SS113, SS119, , SS123, SS128, BE151, ES114a, ES123, SS222, SS223, ES228, SS228, SS234

5. First Year Repeat Students

Where a student enrolled in Year One of the programme in the academic year 2013/14 is required to repeat Year One in the academic year 2014/15 they will sit (a) the module (s) which they did not pass in the initial academic session if it is still offered on the new structure or (b) a replacement module as indicated below.

SS118 - students must take SS128 with the credits increased from 5 – 7.5

6. Second Year Repeat Students

Where a student enrolled in Year Two of the programme in the academic year 2013/14 is required to repeat Year Two in the academic year 2014/15, they will sit (a) the module (s) which they did not pass in the initial academic session if it is still offered on the new structure or (b) a replacement module as indicated below.

CS214 students must take CS216

ES216 students must take ES228 with the credits increased from 5 – 10

PS226 students must take PS227 with the credits increased from 5 – 7.5

PS216 students must take PS219 with the credits decreased from 7.5 to 5

Students will also be required to take module PS220 to complete year 2.
