BSc in Psychology

1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

The degree classification is based on 90 credits (30 credits from Semester 1, year 3 and 60 credits year 4). It is calculated on the basis of module weightings as contained in the academic structures for years 3 - 33.33% and 4 66.66%)

An attendance of 75% is mandatory for successful completion of the following modules:

2. Derogations from Marks & Standards
