1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

Compulsory attendance: All language modules in Years 1 and 2 require that students attend at least 80% of language classes. Where a student fails to do so, and in the absence of documentation to support extenuating circumstances, s/he will be required to present for a meeting with the Programme Chair, SALIS Teaching Convenor and/ or Module Coordinator in advance of attempting examinations/ assessments and/ or submitting coursework.

On completion of 30 ECTS credits of taught core modules students can exit this programme with a Graduate Certificate in International Relations.

On completion of 60 ECTS credits of taught core and taught optional modules students can exit this programme with a Graduate Diploma in International Relations.
