# **PROGRAMME REGULATIONS 2014-2015**

Programme Title: MSc in Education and Training Management (Leadership)

**Programme Code: MEML** 

Offering Type: Part-time (02)

## 1. Programme-specific rules and requirements

### 1.1 Attendance

Good attendance at class sessions is paramount in order to participate fully in all aspects of the programme. A minimum of 75% attendance at class sessions is required for each module [Ref.: DCU M&S V.2013.1, Item 3.1.2]. Special arrangements will be made for extenuating circumstances. In the absence of documentation to support extenuating circumstances, the student will be required to present for a meeting with the Programme Chair or Co-ordinator in advance of submitting coursework.

## 1.2 Assignments

Assignments must be submitted on or before the published submission due time and date.

10% of the marks achieved will be deducted for assignments submitted up to 1 week after the due date. 20% of the marks achieved will be deducted for assignments submitted up to 2 weeks after the due date. 30% of the marks achieved will be deducted for assignments submitted up to 3 weeks after the due date.

Assignments will not be accepted after three weeks of the due assignment date.

### 2. Derogations from Marks & Standards

## 3. Progression

Students must have successfully completed a minimum of 40 credits in a study period in order to progress to the next study period. Under exceptional circumstances, and subject to the approval of the Progression and Award Board, students may be permitted to carry a maximum of one module into Year 2 [Ref.: DCU M&S V.2013.1, Item 7.1.9].

Students who have successfully completed 60 ECTS credits, excluding module ES511 Thesis / Practicum, are permitted to exit with a Graduate Diploma in Education and Training Management (Leadership) [Ref.: DCU M&S V.2013.1, Item 1.1.4, Item 8.1.5].

### 4. Compensation

Compensation is not permitted for taught postgraduate programmes [Ref.: DCU M&S V.2013.1, Item 7.1.10].
