INFORMATION ON ACADEMIC DRESS

PhD graduands wear a red gown with navy sleeves, a hood with gold-coloured lining, and a bonnet with a gold tassel.

GOWNS

Master's graduands wear a black gown with glove (closed) sleeves. All other graduands wear a black gown with wing (bell-shaped) sleeves.

MORTAR BOARDS

The wearing of a mortar board is optional for both Male and Female graduands.

HOODS

Graduands on undergraduate and Master's degree programmes wear a hood which falls behind the shoulders. The Master's degree hood is longer at the back than the undergraduate degree hood. The edging band on the Master's hood is normally about one inch thicker than the edging band on the undergraduate hood.

EPITOGE

Graduands on certificate and diploma programmes wear an epitoge (a strip of material worn over the left shoulder). In the case of undergraduate certificates, the epitoge has one stripe. In the case of undergraduate diplomas, the epitoge has two stripes. In the case of graduate certificates, the epitoge has three stripes. In the case of graduate diplomas, the epitoge has the epitoge has four stripes.

The colour of the hood and epitoge relate to the Faculty which offers the programme as follows:
