PI INFORMATION:	Biography (100 words) Prof. Anne Matthews is Head of School and an Associate Professor at the School of Nursing & Human Sciences, where she lectures on the BSc Health and Society and carry out Health Services Research, particularly focused on the nursing workforce. Dr Matthews has been working at DCU since 2001 in research and lecturing roles. Anne qualified as a Registered General Nurse in 1990 and a Registered Midwife in 1992. She graduated from University College Dublin with a B.Soc.Sc. (Social Policy, Library & Information Studies) in 1995 and with a M.Sc. (Econ.) in Social Policy and Planning from the London School of Economics and Political Science in 1996. Anne worked in the Department of Social Policy and Social Work in UCD, the Centre for Social Research of the University of Malawi, and as Chief Officer for the Council for Children's Hospitals' Care until taking up a research position at DCU in July 2001 as Research Fellow, on a Research Project on Empowerment of nurses and midwives. Dr Matthews was a Lecturer in Nursing and Health Policy from February 2003- 2004 and has a PhD from DCU in 2006; her thesis was entitled "Past and present perspectives on power and empowerment in midwifery in Ireland".
