Meetings

The REC processed 135 applications for ethical review. Full committee review was required for 10 of those applications, 41 were processed by expedited review, and 84 were processed via the notification procedure.

Ethical Awareness

An REC workshop on Risk Assessment took place on Wednesday 4_{th} June 2008 –the guest speaker was Dr. Kevin Kelleher, (Assistant National Director, Population Health - Health Protection, Health Service Executive, and chair of the UL Research Ethics Committee).
