Brief summary of research group / centre activity:

MedEx is a chronic illness rehabilitation programme, offering supervised exercise classes to individuals with diverse chronic illnesses, with a parallel educational content. MedEx is one of the largest centres of its kind in Europe. It offers a novel public health delivery model with realistic potential for national and international roll out.

Description of postdoctoral project on offer:

It is proposed to carry out a robust and critical evaluation of MedEx, using outcome measures related to a. Functional Capacity (strength, flexibility, aeriobic fitness, balance) b. Cognitive Function c. Quality of Life d. Health Care Utilisation. e. biomarker profiling f. co-morbidity profiling. The evaluation will be carried out over a 2 year period and will have 2 main aims namely 1. to critically evaluate the personal and health economic impacts of MedEx 2. to identify factors that predict responsivemeness to MedEx
