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2.	<p>The REC Chair confirmed that the REC Terms of Reference (ToR) and the devolvement document, which outlines the requirements for establishing Faculty Research Ethics Committees (FRECs), have now been approved by Research Committee (RC). Currently, only the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences will be devolving for the new academic year.</p> <p>The REC Chair will be stepping down from their position on the 30th of June 2021. It is hoped that the new REC Chair will be in place shortly and this will be communicated to the committee as soon as it has been officially confirmed.</p> <p>DCU REC has received 178 applications for review for 2021 to date. This is a 14% increase from the same point in June 2020 and a 43.5% increase from the same point in June 2019. All of this would not be possible without the hard work of DCU REC members who have facilitated, and continue to facilitate, the review of research applications.</p> <p>The Chief Operations Officer is currently finalising the DCU Child Protection Policy and Training requirements. The links to these will sit on the DCU REC Portal on Loop. Likewise, the Data Protection Unit (DPU) has agreed to provide a link on the REC Portal for GDPR training. The REC administrator will also be recording a video introduction to their role, which will live on the REC Portal.</p> <p>The current upgrade to the REC application review and approval system is ongoing. The AWB meets every 3 months and provides any relevant updates to the REC.</p> <p>The EU Commission and the Health Products Regulatory Authority (HPRA) in Ireland have provided guidance on the use of non-animal models for conducting breast cancer research. As a result, researchers will need to exhaust all non-animal approaches (e.g. developing and producing antibodies from non-animal sources) in order to receive approval from the HPRA and conduct their research.</p>		
4.	<p>An outstanding item from the previous meeting minutes on the 21st of May 2021 was the collation of common errors / omissions that applicants make. The REC Chair thanked members for providing their input and as a result has highlighted some of the most common errors / omissions that applicants make in the REC application guidance videos that are currently under development.
