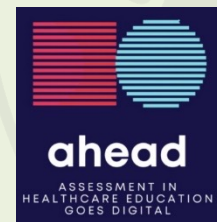

Digital Peer Assessment

- Necessity to turn some activities in digital even in Medical Programs

- Selected skills – Hand washing, Sterile glove application, Venipuncture



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Digital Peer Assessment

- The rubrics were created by the faculty members
- The grades of the criteria's differ according to the content
- The Moodle Assignment was created and pre-defined rubrics was activated
- Students embedded their videos in the textbox of the assignment and submitted
- The reviewers were given the teacher role for the selected assignment to grade the submissions
